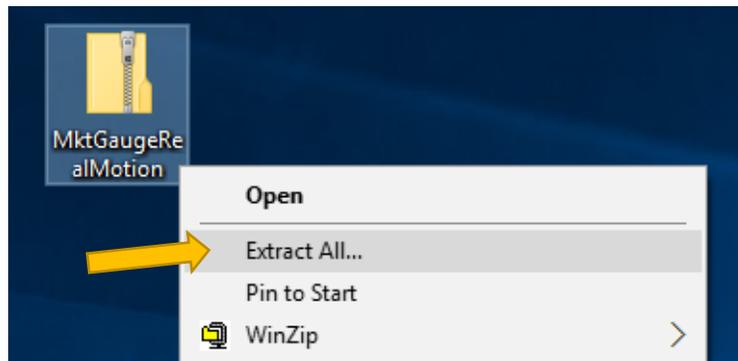


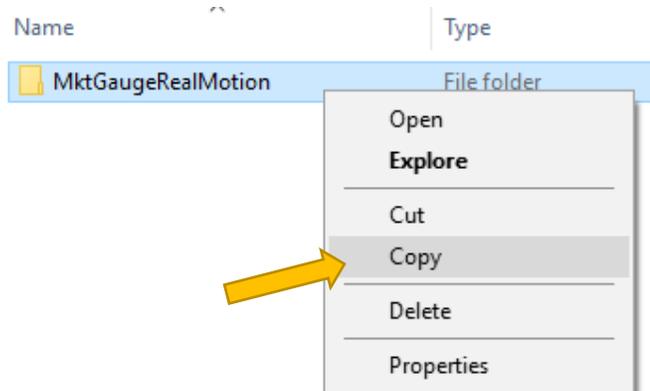


Installation of MarketGauge RealMotion Indicators on TradeStation®

1. From our website, download the file “MktGaugeRealMotion.zip” – this will either give you the option to specify where you can save the file or it will automatically download it to your downloads folder.
2. The folder you downloaded contains two files that have to be unzipped. This can be accomplished several different ways:
 - a. You can right-click on the zip folder and select “Extract All...” A window will pop up where you can specify the destination for the files.



- b. You can open up the compressed folder, highlight the file(s) or folder and right-click on it and select “Copy” – then “Paste” them onto your **desktop or any other folder**. (You can also use keyboard shortcuts “Ctrl-C” and “Ctrl-V”).

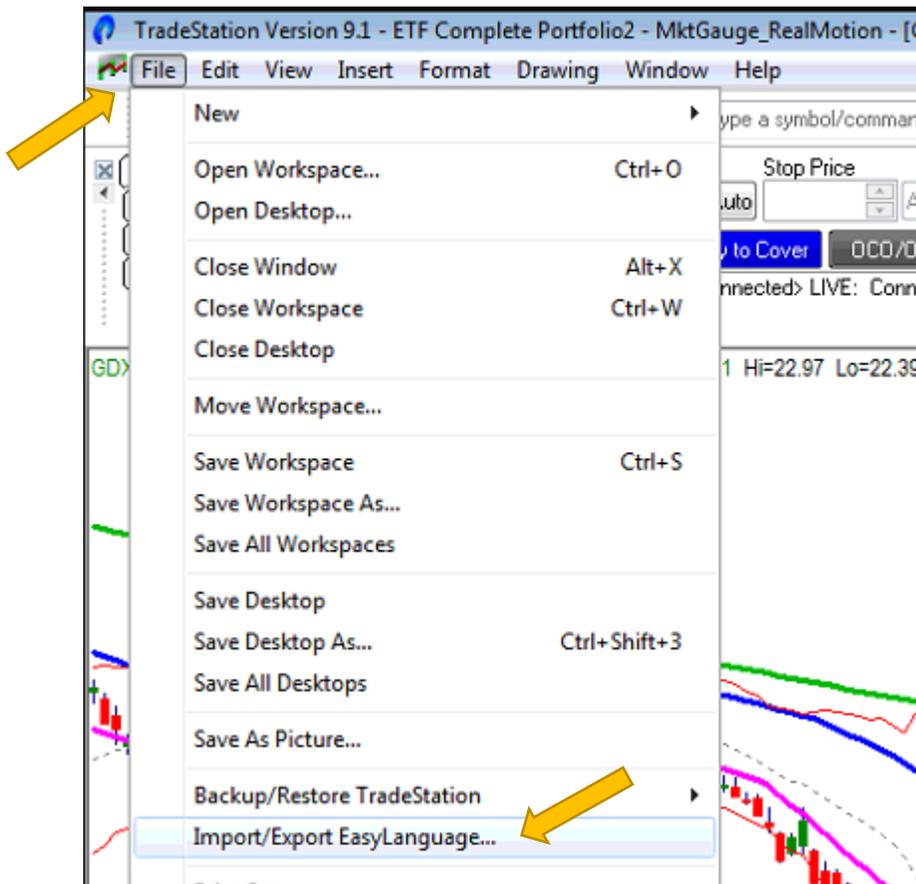


- c. If you have WinZip or WinRAR installed, you can use either of those programs to un-compress the two files.

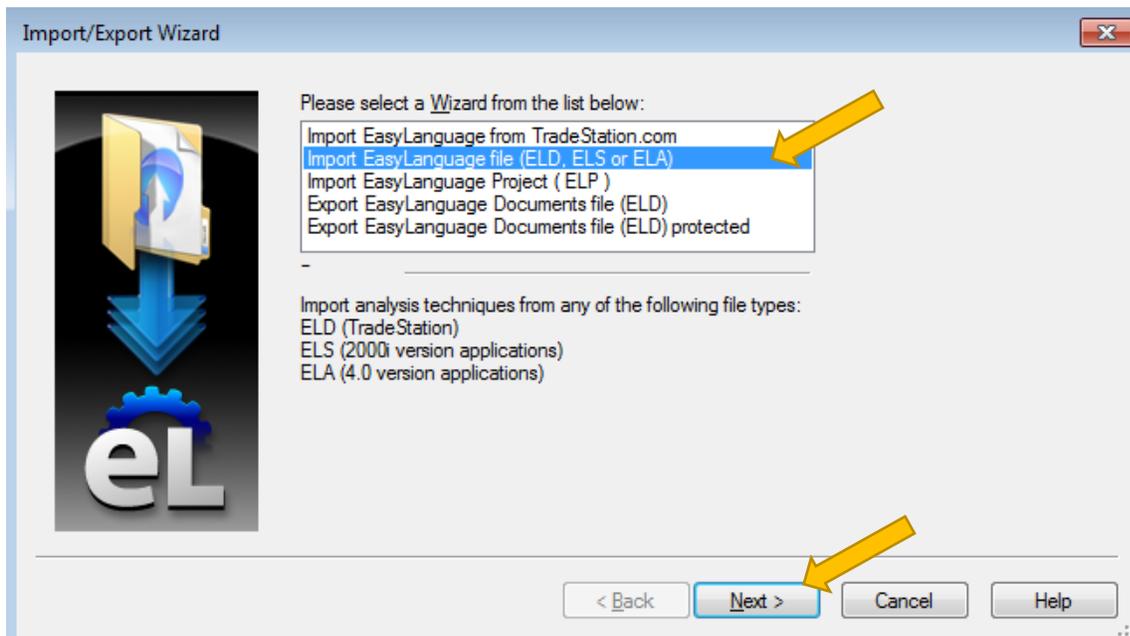


- d. The important thing is that you need to get the file outside of its original compressed folder.

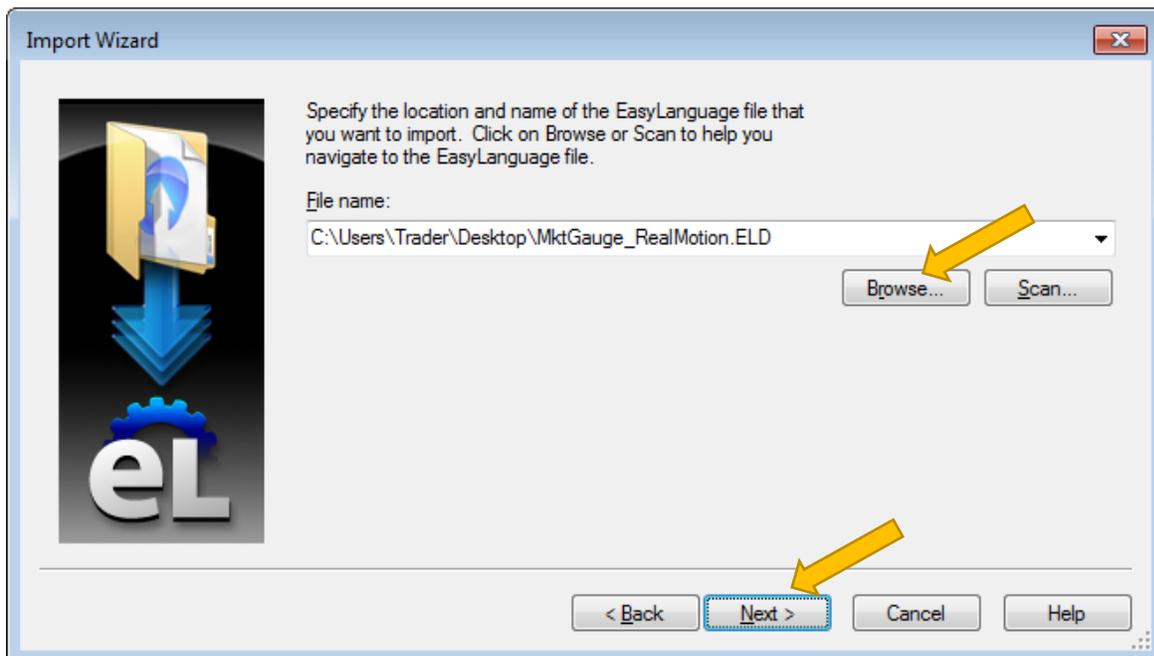
3. Open up the Tradestation platform. Go to the “File” menu and select “Import/Export EasyLanguage...”



4. Highlight second option: "Import EasyLanguage file (ELD, ELS or ELA)" and click "Next >"



5. Use "browse" to locate the "MktGauge_RealMotion.ELD" file (wherever your downloaded or extracted the file). Then click "Next >"



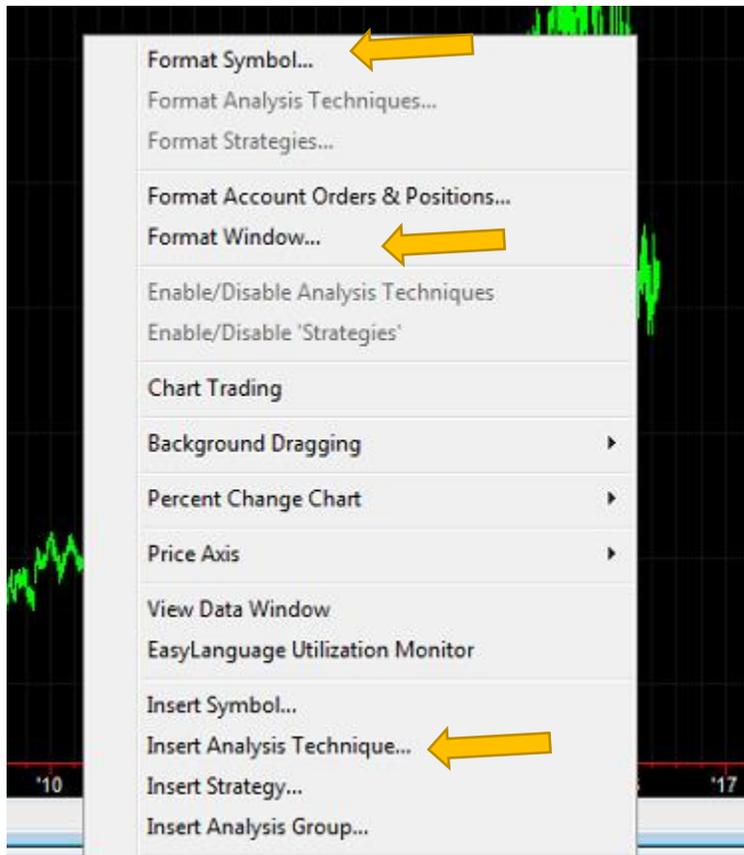
6. Continue clicking “Next >” through the next set of windows until Tradestation confirms it has added the indicator.
7. If you are using TradeStation 9.1 Update 29 (or newer), you may be able to use the provided workspace: MktGauge_RealMotion.tsw. The layout should look similar to the example below. If this works, you are done installing the indicators and may begin to use it.



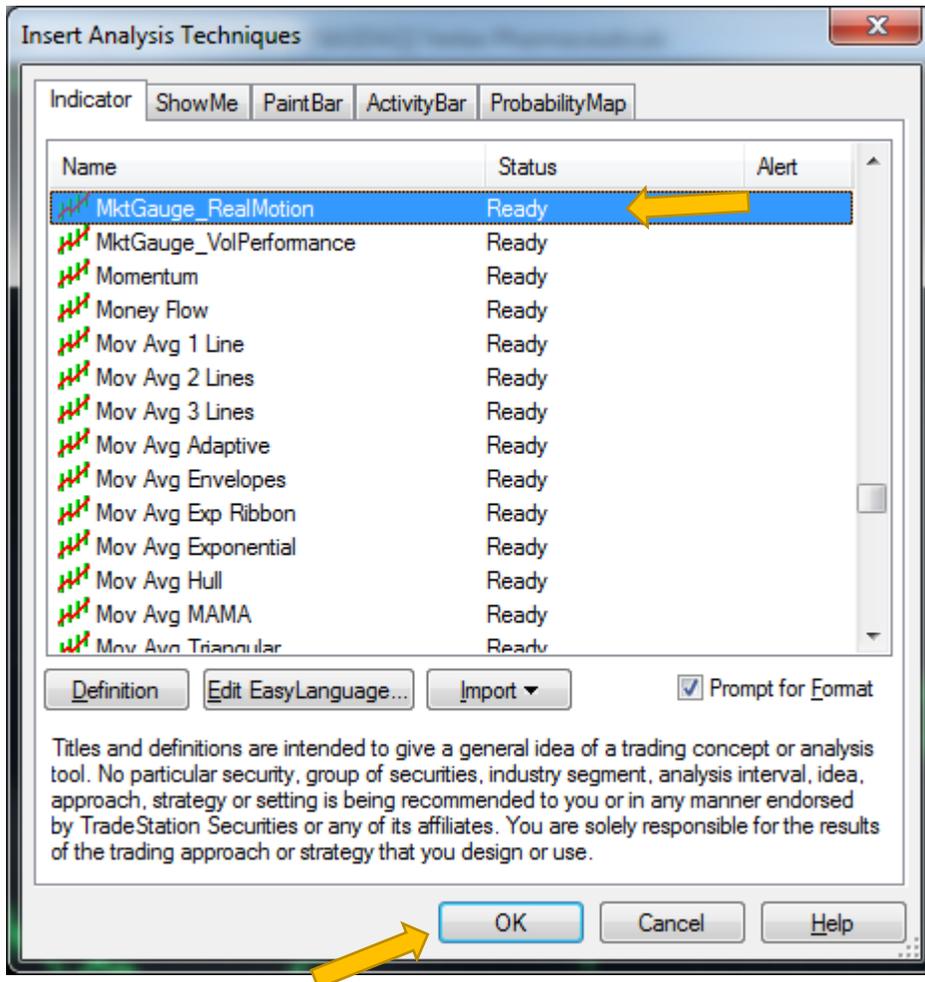
8. If you are unable to use the provided workspace, you can manually recreate it. We will provide the basic standardized style and formatting for a white chart. You can use whatever style and colors you prefer.

Recreating the MktGauge_RealMotion.TSW Workspace

1. Create a new workspace and save it. Then create a new “chart analysis” chart window. Format the symbol to load at least 3 years of daily data (more is preferred) and set the bar type style to Candlestick. You can change the chart background to white (and time/price axis to black) from the “Format Window” dialog box (accessible by right-clicking on a chart).



- Next add the new indicator by right-clicking on chart and selecting “Insert Analysis Technique..” (shown above). Locate the indicator: “MktGauge_RealMotion” and click “OK”



3. This should open up a “Format Indicator” window (or you can go to “Format” → “Analysis Techniques” and select the indicator and then select “Format” to get to the box displayed below. Set the plots to the following colors on the color tab:

Real Motion = Brown

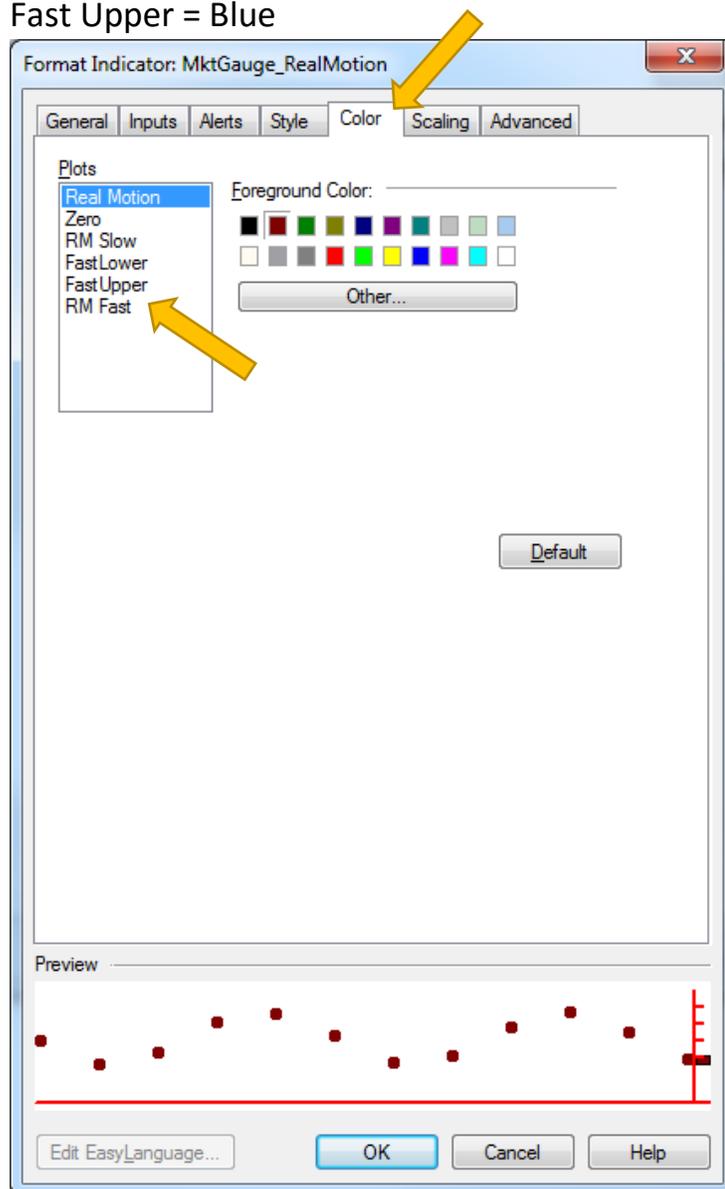
Zero = Black

RM Slow = Green

RM Fast = Blue

Fast Lower = Blue

Fast Upper = Blue



4. In the style tab, make the following changes (you can set the style to however you prefer to have it displayed).

Real Motion: Type=Point and Weight=5th option

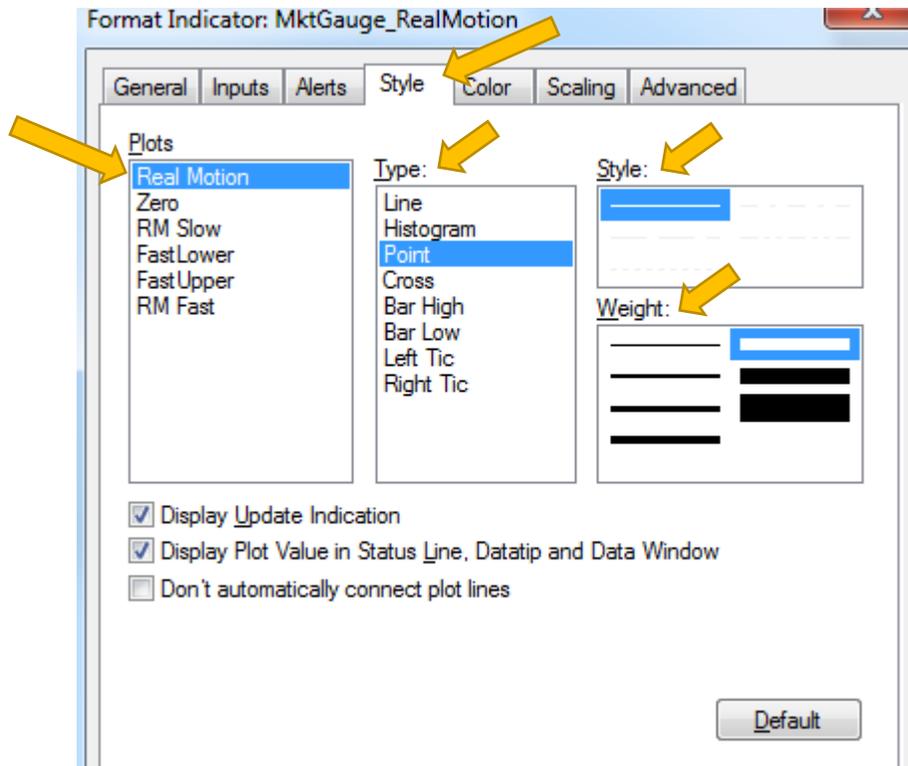
Zero: Weight = 3rd option thickness

RM Slow: Weight = 3rd option thickness

Fast Lower: Style=Last Dotted Option

Fast Upper: Style=Last Dotted Option

RM Slow: Weight = 3rd option thickness



5. You can add 3 standard moving averages to the price series (200 day, 50 day, 10 day) and Bollinger bands as displayed below.
