





Installation of MarketGauge RealMotion Indicators on thinkorswim

1. From our website, download the file “MGRealMotionThinkorSwim.zip” – this will either give you the option to specify where you can save the file or it will automatically download it to your downloads folder.
2. The folder you downloaded contains one file that has to be unzipped. This can be accomplished several different ways:
 - a. You can right-click on the zip folder and select “Extract All...” A window will pop up where you can specify the destination for the files.



- b. You can open up the folder, highlight the file and right-click on it and select “Copy” – then “Paste” them onto your **desktop or any other folder**. (You can also use keyboard shortcuts “Ctrl-C” and “Ctrl-V”).




- c. If you have WinZip or WinRAR installed, you can use either of those programs to un-compress the two files.




- d. The important thing is that you need to get the file outside of its original folder. Do not attempt to open the file. Windows will think it is a media/video file and attempt to play it.


3. Open up the Thinkorswim platform. Go to a standard daily chart of any symbol. You should load the chart with a lot of data (3 years or more). You can change how much data is loaded through this series of menus:




4. Right click anywhere on the chart and select “Studies” and then “Edit Studies” in the second pop-up window.




5. This will open up a new window titled: “Edit Studies and Strategies.” Click on “Import”



6. This will open up another pop-up window titled: “Load Study”
From here you need to navigate and locate the file you downloaded and un-compressed. It will either be on your desktop or whatever folder you put them in. The home icon will take you to your desktop. You can also use “Look in” dropdown to navigate to the file location. Once you locate the file, click on it and select “Open”



- Once the indicator has been imported, we can now add it to our daily chart. From the “Edit Studies and Strategies” window, we can search for our indicator by typing “mkt” into upper left search box. Then we can add the indicator to a chart by double-clicking on it or right-clicking and choosing “add selected.” When it has been added to a chart, it will show up in a “Lower” section as shown below on the right-hand side. You can adjust it to display in a different section using the arrow icon.



8. If both indicators are imported and added correctly, they will look something like the ones shown below. Your indicator colors and sizes will vary. You can now add these indicators to any chart or any other existing workspace. For reference, we have added two simple moving averages on the price chart (50 day in blue and 200 day in green).
