



Setup for MarketGauge TriplePlay Indicator on TC 2000

For TC2007 start with a blank chart (no indicators) of your chosen stock. Select Edit at the top of the chart. A pop up window will appear. All of the changes to the chart are done in this window.

To Create the Candle Stick chart with 3 moving averages:

If Prices are not already candlesticks, click on the hand writing on the tablet. Choose candle stick.

Click on the plus sign after prices. Select Moving Average. Type in 10 for the Period.

Click on the color and change it to green. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign again. Select Moving Average. Type in 20 for the Period. Click on the color and change it to red. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign again. Select Moving Average. Type in 50 for the Period. Click on the color and change it to purple. Close the window.

Add a Bollinger band around the stock price with length 20 and width 2.

To Create the Price Trend Performance:

Click on the plus sign after Middle. Select Relative Strength. Type in SP-500 as the Comparison Symbol. Choose red. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign after Relative Strength. Choose Moving Average. Type in 20 for the Period. Choose blue for the color. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign after Relative Strength. Choose Moving Average. Type in 125 for the Period. Choose blue for the color. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign after Relative Strength. Choose Bollinger Bands. Choose 20 for the Period and 1.0 as the Width. Select Dot as the Draw Style. Close the window.

To Create the Volume Trend Performance:

Click on the plus sign after Bottom. Select On Balance Volume. Select red for the color.

Click on the plus sign after On Balance Volume. Select Moving Average. Type in 20 for the Period. Select blue for the color. Close the window.

Click on the plus sign after On Balance Volume. Select Bollinger Bands. Choose 20 for the Period and 1.0 as the Width. Select Dot as the Draw Style. Close the window. Select Save As and give the Chart Template a title.
